WHAT DOES GOLDMAN SACHS CUSTODY SOLUTIONS DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security Number and income
- Transaction history and account balances
- Assets and employment information

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Goldman Sachs Custody Solutions chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Goldman Sachs Custody Solutions protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Goldman Sachs Custody Solutions collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Give us your contact information or open an account ▪ Deposit money ▪ Direct us to buy securities or direct us to sell your securities <p>We also may get your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit some, but not all, sharing relating to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness ▪ Affiliates using your information to market to you ▪ Nonaffiliates using your information to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account—unless you tell us otherwise.

Other Important Information

For CA Customers: In accordance with California law, we will not share information we collect about California residents with nonaffiliates unless the law allows. For example, we may share information with your consent or to service your accounts. We will limit sharing among our companies to the extent required by California law.
